The U.S. Department of Energy's (DOE) Integrated Contractor Purchasing Team (ICPT) has established a Basic Ordering Agreement (BOA) to facilitate seamless connections between DOE's seventeen National Laboratories and the Management & Operating (M&O) Community, enabling them to collaborate with trusted partners for reliable staffing and services.

This BOA is utilized by procurement professionals throughout the DOE National Laboratory complex to streamline the ordering process for common items and services used by all national laboratories.

Scope Areas



Business and Project Management (BP) - Accounting, procurement, finance, training, project management, project controls, etc.



Communications and Outreach – Media for internal and external communications, social media management, technical writing and editing, conference support, videography, etc.



Engineering (EN) – Engineering, including drawing/design.

*Does not include developing software for cyber engineering functions.



Information Technology (IT) – Programming in many specialized codes or product-specific languages, cybersecurity, software engineering, hardware support, software support, implementation, and system integration, etc.



Science & Technical (ST) – Specialized technical areas in both research and support. Types of workers include waste operations specialists, environmental specialists, researchers, radiation control technicians, research assistants, etc.
